



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Programme Highlights:






Programme Highlights:

2. To make awareness regarding conservation of plants.


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Programme Highlights:



Programme Highlights:



Historically, the Ashirgad fort is unique; the main objective of this educational trip was to make the students aware of the fort and religious places of ancient time. The participants could know the historical significance as well as administration of the fort.


It is a historical & strategically important fort about 14 miles far from Burhanpur. It is a historic, invincible fort at the top of a mount of Satpuda hills. This was very important fort to regulate southern part of India, as some historian addressed it with the name "the key of deccan" some author said that after conquering this fort, ways to seizing southern area or 'Khandesh' became easier. It is about 259.1 meter high from its base and 701 meter high from sea level. There is a mosque, Lord Shiva temple and one palace inside the fort. It is actually developed in 3 parts and each part has its own name. First part is

called "Asirgarh", second part is "Kamargarh" and thrid part is called "Malaygarh".

Objectives:

- 1. To aware farmers about the hazardous impacts of excess use of chemical fertilizers and pesticides.
- 2. To promote team work among the enrolled students.
- 3. To generate inquiry and counseling abilities of students
- 4. To enhance leadership qualities among the group of students.
- 5. To inculcate experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving techniques among the students enrolled in this program
- 6. This activity is aims to provide primary knowledge to students about gathering data, interrelating, interpreting the collected data and its analysis.
- 7. This program aims to restrict utilization of chemical fertilizers and pesticides among farmers.
- 8. This program also aims to promote environmental protection by awaking farmers about the hazardous effects of chemical fertilizers and pesticides.
- 9. This awareness program will help to develop communication skill among the participants of this activity.

Introduction:

The idea behind this program is to aware farmers about recently concerning issue of excess use of chemical fertilizers, insecticides and pesticide used especially on the vegetable crop by the farmers due to lack of awareness. The important role of nation building has been assigned to the higher education institute which makes it imperative for teachers and students to participate in the community. The extension and community centered activities achieve the goal of building the sustainable community. The traditional role of institutions of higher learning is to carry out two important functions teaching and research. In the current context, this role requires to undergo a change and colleges are no more expected merely to function in isolation as islands of excellence. The University Grants Commission in its policy frame has added extension and community centered activities as the third important role for institution of higher education. The excess use of chemical fertilizers insecticides and pesticides in the agricultural field not only cause harm to the consumer of the crop but also it decreases the quality of production, contributes in pollution of soil, water and air. The credits of pesticides include enhanced economic production in terms of increased production of vegetables then their debits have resulted in serious health implications to man and its environment. There is now overwhelming evidence that some of these chemical fertilizers and pesticides do pose a potential risk to humans

and other life forms and unwanted side effects on the environment. Keeping this in mind the institute's faculty of Science and NCC collaboratively takes this initiative together with guidance of IQAC and respected Principal of our college. Most of the students enrolled in our college come from the agricultural background and live in rural area so it is possible to generate their interest in this activity. The framework of this program is basically two dimensional and at the end it will benefit both the community and the students engaged in this activity. With the hope that above stated problem could be minimized by the intervention of institute through the students by awaking farmers of this region.



Implications

3.3.1 Extension Activities

Any activity which is planned to benefit community is having its own implications but the possible outcomes and future prospective are also analyzed before going to implement the activity so as to measure the intensity of target to be achieved after completion of activity. The present extension activity basically aims to aware famers about the excess use of chemical fertilizers and pesticides to reduce pollution and to increase the quality of food products obtained from agricultural produce. The Sangrampur Taluka is a good producer of vegetable crop and the most of students enrolled in our institution belong to the villages in the Sangrampur tehsil. Considering this as an opportunity, the institute faculties explored the possibilities of creating awareness with the help of students by guiding them. We as responsible institute, expect bidirectional benefits as the students learn to collect data, analyze it and provide response accordingly. At the end of this extension activity we expect that we will convince and encourage all the farmers for minimum use of chemical fertilizers and pesticides.

Summary Report of Activity


The institute is located in agriculture rich area as well as the students enrolled in our institute are belonging to agricultural background, so the institute takes it as an opportunity to initiate the proposed activity. Near about 37 students from all three faculties have participated in this awareness program under the guidance of faculties mentioned above.

This extension activity was a multidimensional experience for students, as the activity is planned in such a way that students would get benefit while achieving objectives of the activity. As per the plan of activity students have interacted with the local farmers to know about the utilization of chemical fertilizers and pesticides (the data capture format was provided with this report). After this, faculties and students meet to discuss about the data obtained from farmers and make their conclusions. It is seen that the maximum farmers utilize chemical fertilizers and pesticides in their crop fields so as to increase their production of crops. It is also seen that the farmers' expenditure on fertilizers and pesticides is extensive, so it is essential to suggest some other alternatives such as, compost, Vermin compost, Vermiwash, Neemseed extract, Jivamrut, Bijamrut, Ricewater, Dashaparni ark, Nimastra, Agniastra, arogreen fermented fruit juice, Garbez enzyme, Amrutkavach, Enriched amrut ghol, and many more. After this the students planned to re-visit the farmers to interact with them so as to discuss about limited use of chemical fertilizer and pesticides, together with this students had shared the implications of excess use of pesticides and fertilizers on environment, human health, soil health etc. and suggested them alternatives for chemical based pesticides and fertilizers. Students have also


distributed the brochures depicting alternatives for chemical based pesticides and fertilizers, already published by the agriculture department (some of them attached with this report).


