The parties understand that in the association, they shall have access to confidential information provided by the other party. Accordingly, the parties agree that such information which is by its nature, not confidential or which is in the public domain or which the party comes to know about other than through violation of any law of legal obligation, provided that such party may be entitled to disclose such information if legally required to be disclosed to a competent authority. Failure to maintain confidentiality shall entitle the affected party to terminate the MoU.

7. The MoU would remain valid for a period of Five years from the date it is signed by the parties and is renewable on mutual consent for such further period as agreed upon.

## E. Terms and Review

The MoU shall be reviewed at the end of one year from the date of singing of this MoU. Either party can terminate the Mo'J after giving one month's notice to the other party subject to fulfillment of commitments already agreed upon.

## 9. Amendments

This MoU constitutes the entire sudgestanding between the parties hereto, Except as otherwise provided herein, no addition, amendment to or modification of this MoU shall be affected unless it is in writing and signed by and on behalf of both parties by their respective authorized signatories.




