

## **A. Academic and Learning Resources Facilities:**

## E. Sports & Cultural Activities

### Sports Facilities: -

Since our management believes in a development of students, so they have provided a well-maintained campus spread over 92800 sq.feet, of peaceful green land. 6. For athletics, 2 short-puts, 2 discs, 2 javelin
7. For indoor games 2 carom boards, 5 chess boards.

**b) Extra-curricular activities:** - Extracurricular activities are as important as co-curricular activities. In order to make the students competent enough, the college tries its best to provide all the possible avenues for the holistic development of a student. 

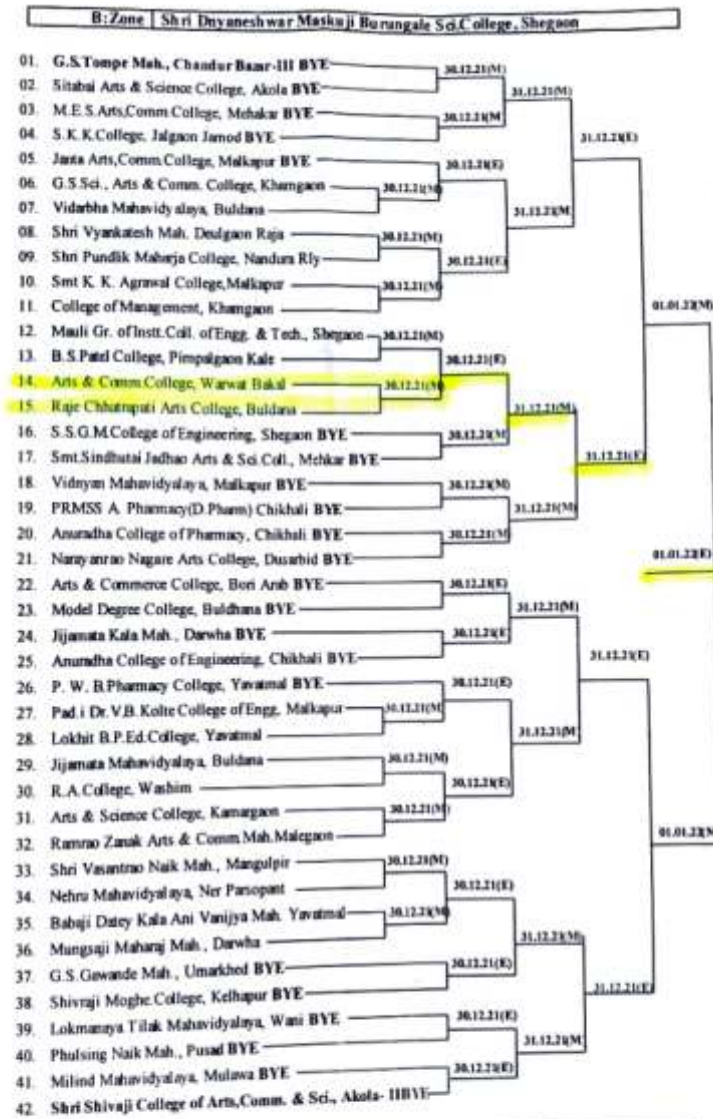
