

AMC FOR COLLEGE CANTEEN

This annual maintenance contract is entered into between Shri. Santosh Kale R/o Warvat Bakal Ta-Sangrampur Dist- Buldana (herein after referred as Contractor) and Arts and Commerce College, Warwat Bakal.

The contractor herein after agrees to provide the canteen services in college premises subject to the following terms and conditions.

- The contract shall be for a period of one year with effect from the date of signing of agreement for running the canteen.
- The contract can be renewed for further period of duration of which would be determined mutual
 agreement and terms and conditions which may be agreed upon by the college Principal and
 Contractor.
- 3. The contractor shall pay a sum of Rs. 800/- per month as license fee to be paid in advance for each month.
- The contractor shall obtain certificate /license from the local authority (Gram Panchayat) for running the canteen on behalf of the college.
- 5. That the canteen is meant for the exclusive use of the students and the staff of the college, it shall be the responsibility of contractor not to entertain any outsider. However, any persistence by the outsiders shall be reported in writing to the Principal.
- 6. The contractor will keep the rates and quality, as per the agreement and the same shall be displayed in the canteen on a board for the benefit to the customer.
- 7. The college shall provide canteen premises fitted with room fans, exhaust fans, tube lights.
- 8. The maintenance and upkeep of seating area and kitchen, furniture, fixture, fitting will be the responsibility of the contractor, however if any property is damaged by student(s), the same shall be reported immediately to the Principal of the college failing which the contractor shall be held responsible for the damage.
- 9. That the college shall always have the right to inspect the premises.
- 10. On termination of the contract, the property of the college shall be returned in the same condition in which the contractor had taken it from the Principal.
- 11. That the contract can be terminated by either party by giving 30 days' notice in writing.
- 12. The personal hygiene of the canteen staff shall be of high order i.e. clean nails, monthly haircut, clean clothes, hand napkins and canvas shoes.
- 13. That only gas ovens and stoves will be used for cooking.
- 14. That the crockery and cutlery will be rinsed in a solution of potassium paramagnet before use.
- 15. That all edibles shall be kept covered.
- 16. Drinking water quality shall be maintained by the contractor.
- 17. That one cleaner exclusively for the purpose of cleaning the table shall be maintained by the contractor, the bearers shall not be the cleaners.

- 18. Sweeping and cleaning of the premises and collection and disposal of garbage shall be the responsibility of the contractor.
- 19. The crockery shall be cleaned every Sunday with brush and detergent to remove dirt from inconspicuous parts and from the inside of the containers.
- 20. The contractor shall employ only those bearers and cooks who have been cleared by proper medical authorities. A medical examination report shall be submitted as and when required.
- 21. The contractor will not employ anyone under the age of 18 in any capacity.
- 22. The contractor would be responsible for the salary and other benefits to all the persons employed by
- 23. The contractor or any of his employees will not sell any tobacco product and carbonated soft drinks within the college premises.
- 24. The contractor shall also be fully responsible for payment of any compensation etc., in case of any injury/casualty or mishap to any of his employees in the college canteen.
- 25. The contractor shall be informed of deficiencies in service, quality of food hygiene etc. by the college verbally or in writing as it deems fit. In case there is no satisfactory response within 3 days, a further 3 days' time would be given in writing and if there is no improvement, notice of the termination would be served by the Principal. The decision of the Principal would be final.
- 26. The Principal shall always have the right to terminate the contract and take possession of the canteen and its property without assigning any reason whatever. The decision of the Principal with regard to any dispute in respect of the contract will be final.
