Concerns that increased UV radiation due to ozone depletion threatened life on Earth, including increased skin cancer in humans and other ecological problems, led to bans on the chemicals and the 1987 Montreal Protocol, which has since been strengthened. The United Nations General Assembly has designated September 16 as the International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer.

Importance of Ozone

Most ozone resides in the stratosphere in a layer of atmospheric oxygen at and above 10 km above sea level. It acts as a shield to protect earth's surface from the sun's harmful ultraviolet radiation. Without this shield, we would be susceptible to skin cancer, cataracts and impaired immune systems.

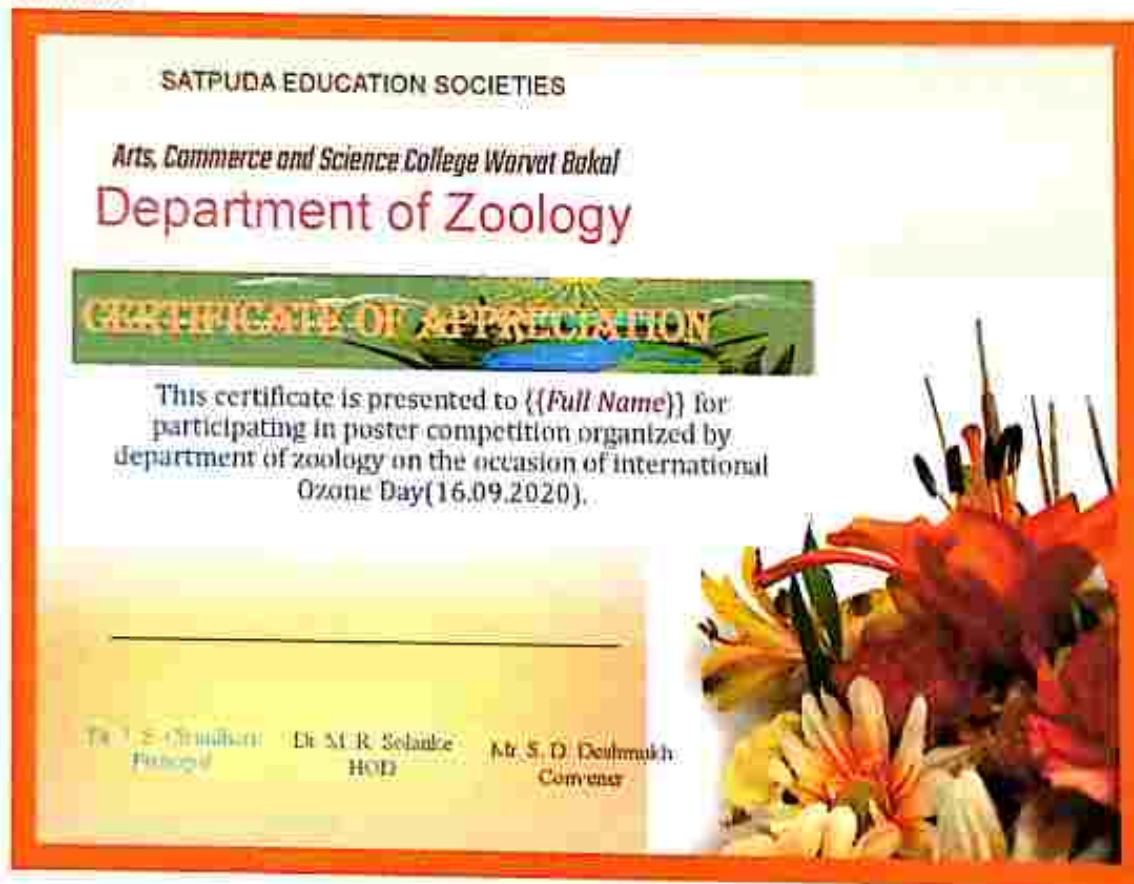

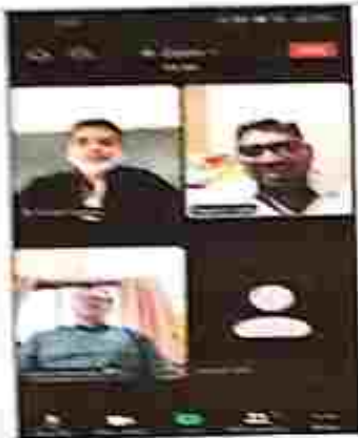

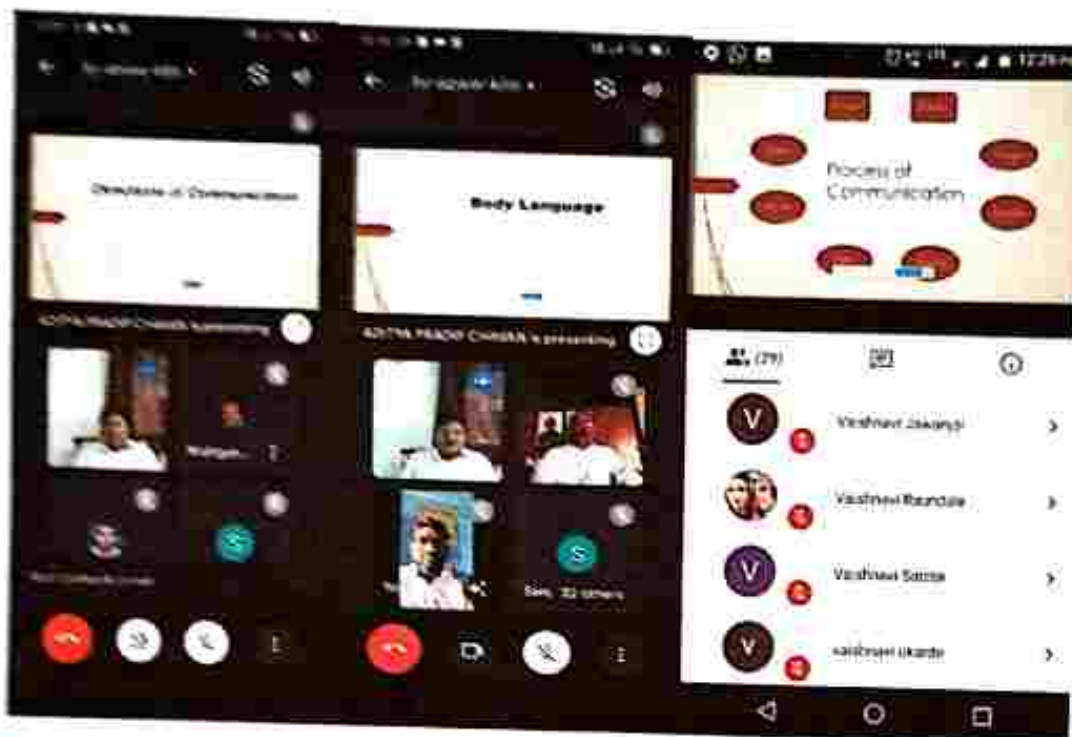
