Outcomes :



2. To know about water conservatism system.


Program highlights:



- Habitat Enhancement: The hanging of earthen pots aimed to enhance sparrow habitats by providing them with a source of drinking water. This would help in supporting the local sparrow populations and promoting their conservation.
- Community Engagement: Celebrating Sparrow Day and hanging earthen pots aimed to engage the college community and the public in conservation efforts by providing them with practical actions they could take to support sparrow conservation.






