Best Practice I

Title of the Practice: "Green Campus: Healthy Campus"

OBJECTIVE:

- 3. To keep the campus green and clean.
- 4. To grow more trees with varieties.
- 5. To help biodiversity conservation.
- 6. To inculcate aesthetic values and eco-consciousness among the students and staff of our institution.
- 7. To create a good ambience for the holistic development of student.
- 8. To improve overall health of the people on campus.
- 9. To support and implement "Swachh Bharat Abhiyan for healthy India."

CONTEXT:

Arts & Commerce College Warwat bakal is situated at the feet of Satpuda ranges. Satpuda forest is one of the hotspot for floral and faunal biodiversity. Our institution is committed to maintain the health and biodiversity of campus that eventually protect our environment. So, being a responsible citizen, we thought it as our duty to contribute something to make the world more beautiful. Corona Pandemic brought some sort of mental stress along with it. In order to remove the stress, warm up is the best medicine. It was decided to work together so that coming together of the colleagues may reduce some sort of mental stress. Thus it became two folded activity. On the one hand, campus became beautiful and clean, on the other we could get some relief from Corona trauma. During "Shramdan" activity we planted flowering plants and cleaned the campus. Challenges we face during the activity are 1) selection of proper plants 2) Safeguarding the plants from monkeys 3) Water management

PRACTICE:

The word Shramdan means labour (Shram) and donation (Daan). Shramdan means a voluntary contribution by the person towards community welfare involving physical efforts. It is a way of helping our community and contributing to help and change the environment around us for betterment of society.

The idea behind the tree plantation activity was to propagate the message of maintaining ecofriendly atmosphere by our own efforts.

We planted various types of saplings with help of students, NSS, NCC volunteers, teaching and non-teaching staff of the college. Initially only staff started this shramdan activity due to total Corona lockdown. However, soon after the lockdown was over, our students also joined us. On every Saturday we would start at 8 in the morning following the rules of covid-19. The plants were made available from nearby nurseries. These are successfully maintained by

providing fertilizers and irrigation facilities.

It helped to make the campus green and clean. Digging the ground for plantation, mixing fertilizer, weeding out the grass benefitted in minimizing the anxiety, stress and depression.

The Corona Pandemic had shut down all the academic and non-academic activities that resulted in communication gap between the stakeholders. This 'shramdan' found to be very effective remedy for us in order to energise ourselves. We could come close to the nature and could interact with each other also.

It was a voluntary service as no one was forced to come and join the task. Everybody who joined this 'Shramadan' had a unique experience of rendering the services for a good cause. It was 'action-oriented experience' for us all. We could practically know the importance of 'action speaks louder'. Everybody who was involved would start digging, ploughing, cleaning, watering, planting by his own intuition. The beauty of flowering plants would make the faces of participants more beautiful because of satisfaction of work done. It is well said that illness generates in mind and then affects the body. Body reacts as per the instructions of mind. We were fortunate enough to keep our minds sound by keeping ourselves busy in 'Shramadan'. It would not be exaggeration to say that none of us could get seriously affected by Covid -19 because of this 'Shramadan'. Thanks to 'Shramadan' for saving us from Corona

PROBLEM ENCOUNTERED AND RESOURCE REQUIRED:

Plantation is not difficult task but major challenge is to maintain and safeguard the planted plants. In our Institute, trees are more likely to be targeted by some pests and insects. Moreover, the monkeys always spoil the plantation. Frequent breakdown of power supply results in scarcity of water during summer. However, we try our best to overcome the challenges.

Best Practice II

TITLE: "Spreading the warmth"

OBJECTIVE:

- To provide blanket to needy person
- To interact with tribal people and understand their problem.
- To provide warmth in winter.
- Bringing neglected people into main stream.
- To make them aware about education.

CONTEXT:

During winter temperature drops down drastically and the added chill in the wind makes the situation worse. Survival becomes difficult for the needy and homeless. Every year hundreds of people become a victim of this phenomenon. The bitterness of winter affects a vast majority of population in ways unimaginable to the comforts of our living room. Our Arts & Commerce College took up the challenge of providing blankets for all these helpless people during the unbearable winter. We donated blankets to the needy people living in nearby villages. The occasion was 72nd birthday of our Founder President Shri. Krushnarao Ingle. It was our meagre effort to reach to the needy people and share some warmth with them. It was our sincere effort to know the troubles of poor, homeless tribal and share their sufferings by giving them the warmth of blanket. We are aware of the fact that mere blanket can not remove their sufferings, nor any monetary help can. However it was an attempt to interact with them and make them express their agony. At least sharing grief might minimize their grief!

PRACTISE:

Every year we celebrate birthday of Shri Krushnrao Ingle, President of Satpuda Education Society by organizing various cultural events in the month of January. It is very blissful moment for all the stakeholders to celebrate the birthday of our patron. The students participate in the cultural events with great zeal and enthusiasm. They let their light shine on the stage of Annual Cultural Events. The third week of January is the most memorable one for all within college campus. They cherish many memories of college life, but the most memorable are these where they sing, dance and act! But this year, Corona shattered their dream of being a part of cultural events. Corona Lockdown ceased all the curricular, co-curricular and extramural activities in 2021-22. This made us browse new ideas to celebrate the birthday of our patron. And ...found an apt one! IQAC suggested to organize such an event which will bring the neglected class of society in touch with main stream. So it was

unanimously decided to share the warmth with blankets. The plan of donating blankets to Tribal was chalked out and implemented. Tribal community is one of the most under - privileged section of our society, who need some sort of support and some sympathetic approach toward them in order to sustain sufficiently in the society. They represent the most primitive livelihood of the race and deserve equal rights as that of the civilized people.

We easily beat the chill of winter with warm, cozy clothes. But there are many people around us who do not have money to afford a day's meal too. So the tribal people were cordially invited to college for interaction. The delicious lunch was organized for them and the return gift was 'a blanket each'. We distributed total 150 blankets to people. The event was organized by following the protocol of covid-19 pandemic by government of India. Disposable mask and sanitizer was provided to the participants.

PROBLEM ENCOUNTERED:

All the tribal people belong to very poor family, they could not afford the travelling expenses to come to the college. Transportation was also ceased because of Corona. So the special arrangement bus was made to bring the needy from their native places.


