

Highlight Local Traditions and Culture:

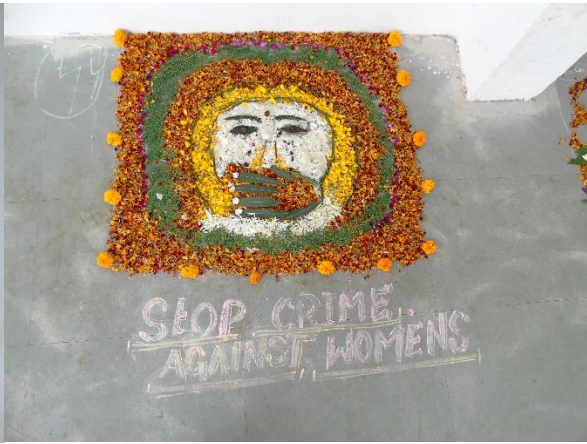

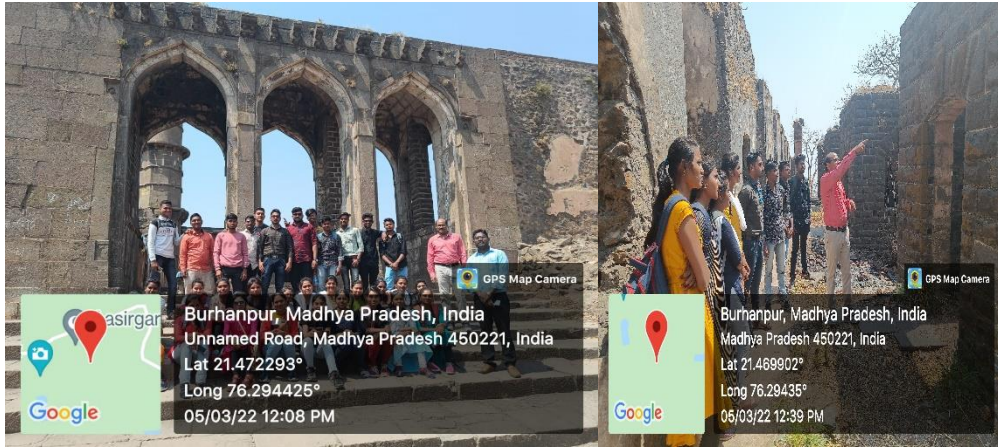

Focus on Sustainability:

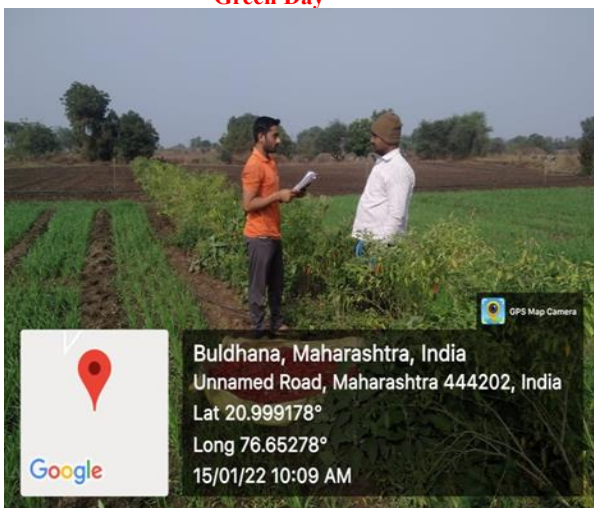
