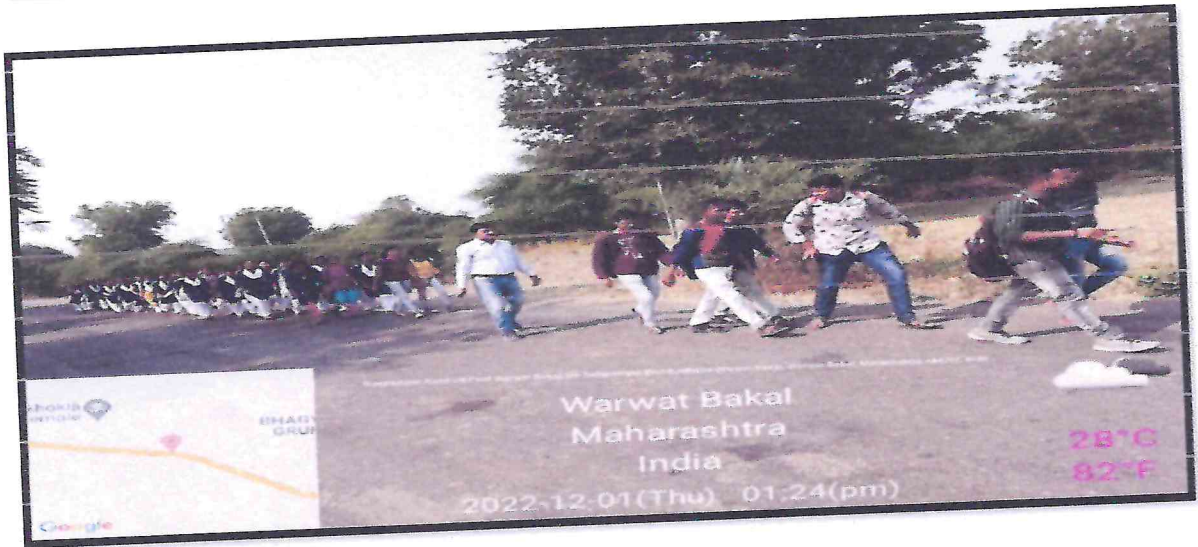

Outcomes:

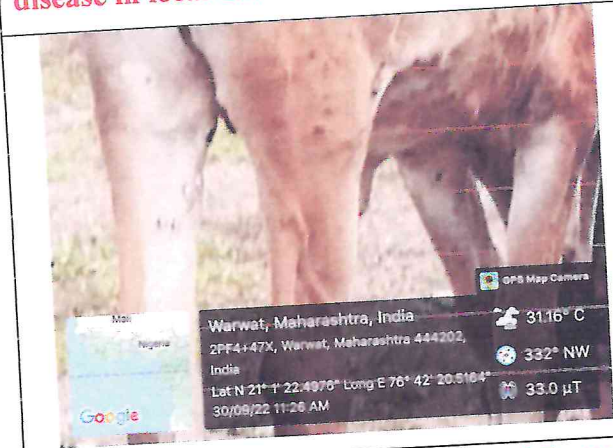
1. Created awareness about upcoming diseases in cattle.
