7. Inspire NCC cadets to become ambassadors of yoga and promote its practice within their families, schools, and communities.


Program Highlights:



Outcomes of the Program:


- Strengthened national pride and respect for the values espoused by Mahatma Gandhi and Lal Bahadur Shastri.
